Prof. Dr. Pradit Hutangkura Scholarship, Academic Year 2026

Faculty of Pharmacy, Mahidol University recognizes the importance of graduate studies which is one of the strategies to provide a highly competent global workforce. Hence, the Faculty of Pharmacy has the policy to provide graduate studies scholarships for high competency students whose study in master and doctoral degree in Faculty of Pharmacy, Mahidol University

Objectives

1. In honor of Prof. Dr. Pradit Hutangkura, founder and the first Dean of Faculty of Pharmacy, Mahidol University.
2. To support high competency students for studying in master and doctoral degree in Faculty of Pharmacy, Mahidol University
3. To increase the number of graduate students in the Faculty of Pharmacy, Mahidol University

Eligibility requirements

1. A new student enrolling in graduate programs of Faculty of Pharmacy in the academic year of 2026 in this following study plan:
 - 1.1 Master degree for plan 1 (research only), plan 1 (research and course work) and plan 2 (independent study)
 - 1.2 Doctoral degree for plan 1.1 (research only, for student who graduated from master degree), 1.2 (research only, for student who graduated from bachelor degree), 2.1 (research and coursework, for student who graduated from master degree) and 2.2 (research and coursework, for student who graduated from Bachelor degree)
2. Has a cumulative GPA (from the previous degree) at least 2.75 out of 4 for students in master degree and 3.25 out of 4 for students in doctoral degree or equal
3. Has an English proficiency score must not exceed 2 years at the application date as directed below:

English proficiency testing	Score
MU Grad Plus	≥ 70
IELTS (academic module)	≥ 5.0
TOEFL-iBT	≥ 64
MU-ELT (only for master degree)	≥ 84

Remark: For applicants who qualified follow “The Announcement of the Division of Graduate, Mahidol University: Exemption from the English Proficiency Test of Graduate Students Mahidol University B.E. 2563”. The applicants can apply for a scholarship without submitting English proficiency score.

Consideration criteria as an added benefit

1. Has a publication relating to academic work or research
2. Has been awarded relating to academic work or research
3. Has talented, experienced or skilled which demonstrates a distinguishing in academic work or research
4. Represents an appropriate idea or how important to be granted for the studies
5. Be a government officer, lecturer or staff who is working in institutes that have an international Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Faculty of Pharmacy, Mahidol University
6. Has an English proficiency score Remark

* Remark: The decisions from the Committee are irrevocable and no further appeal shall be made.

The faculty will grant scholarships as detailed above for the duration of the study plan specified in the program specification (M.M. 2) in which student has enrolled in. The Disbursement follow the announcement of the Division of Graduate, Mahidol University according to Mahidol University Regulations.

Application process

After the admission process is complete, students must apply for the scholarship before the start of the semester.

Attached documents for application

1. Copy of national ID card (Thai student) or passport (international student)
2. Copy of transcript
3. Copy of degree certificate
4. English proficiency score
5. Essay which describes an idea for applicant's studying in the graduate studies or how important of applicants to be granted the scholarship (please prepare no longer than 2 pages A4)
6. Other documents that represent the added benefit (optional)

* Remark: The application would be cancelled if the attached document no. 1 – 5 are not complete at the evaluation date.

Evaluation process and announcement for the scholarship

1. Applicants must be nominated by the program director.
2. Selection of awardee will be done by the Graduate Studies Committee, Faculty of Pharmacy, Mahidol University.
3. The awardee list will be announced by the Division of Graduate Studies and Post-Graduate Studies, Faculty of Pharmacy, Mahidol University.

Termination of scholarships

The scholarship will be terminated by:

1. End of grant duration.
2. Awardees disclaim the acceptance of the scholarship.
3. Awardees resign or terminate from studentship or non-reasonable suspending in study.
4. The program director of the awardee proposed to suspend the grant.
5. Awardees have cumulative GPA less than 3.25 and 3.50 for master and doctoral degree during the study, respectively.
6. Has either "C" or "U" or "F" in the grade report.

Scholarship repayment

Awardees must fully return grant if they could not graduate from the program

In case of other procedures or conditions that are not indicated in this announcement, the Dean of the Faculty of Pharmacy shall review the issue on a case-by-case basis.
