Guidelines for Absence from Examinations for Pharmacy Students

To ensure the smooth operation of procedures for student absence from examinations, the Faculty of Pharmacy has established the following guidelines:

Type of Absence	Details	Score in the Exam Hour
Illness	Hospitalization with a medical certificate from a hospital* AND a guardian's certification.	100% of the full score upon student receiving a make-up exam.
Illness	Not requiring hospitalization, with a medical certificate from a hospital* AND a certification from the academic advisor.	100% of the full score upon student receiving a make-up exam. Subject to the discretion of the Sub-committee.
Illness	Without a medical certificate from a hospital*.	0 score
Urgent Personal Leave (Force Majeure)	E.g., severe illness or death of parents.	100% of the full score upon student receiving a make-up exam. Subject to the discretion of the Sub-committee.

Note: Only medical certificates from government or private hospitals are accepted, but **"not"** including medical certificates from clinics.
