



Announcement of the Faculty of Pharmacy, Mahidol University
Re: Examination Regulations for Undergraduate Students B.E. 2558 (2015)

To comply with the university's policy and to ensure that examinations within the Faculty of Pharmacy, Mahidol University, are conducted with orderliness, transparency, and consistency, the Faculty hereby establishes the following regulations for undergraduate students to strictly adhere to:

Article 1: Students are strictly prohibited from entering the examination room if they are improperly dressed.

Article 2: Students are strictly prohibited from bringing any documents, communication devices, or any similar items into the examination room. Should any such items be found, they will be considered a dishonest act, which will result in penalties in accordance with university regulations, and the items will be confiscated by the university.

Article 3: Students are strictly prohibited from entering or leaving the examination room during the examination.

Article 4: Should a student be found cheating, they will receive an 'F' grade for that course and will be suspended from studies for one subsequent academic semester. The administrative committee may also consider other penalties in accordance with Mahidol University's regulations on student conduct for undergraduate and graduate students B.E. 2551, or as amended.

Article 5: Students must carefully check that the examination paper corresponds to their assigned group and that all pages are complete. They must also clearly write their name and examination number before starting the examination, and strictly follow all instructions provided in the examination paper.

 **Article 6:** Regarding the writing of names, surnames, and student ID numbers on the answer sheets:

6.1 Students must correctly and completely write their name, surname, and student ID number/personal ID number on the answer sheets for multiple-choice questions.

6.2 Students must correctly and completely write their name, surname, and student ID number on every page of the answer sheets for essay questions.

If Article 6.1 and/or Article 6.2 are not followed, that answer sheet will be considered void.

 **Article 7:** Students are prohibited from leaving the examination room within the first **45 minutes** from the start of the examination.

 **Article 8:** Students are prohibited from borrowing any equipment from peers during the examination; otherwise, it will be considered a dishonest act.

 **Article 9:** Students may not claim **ignorance** of the examination regulations and announcements.

 **Article 10:** All students are requested to **display their student ID card clearly** for signing the attendance sheet with a pen.

 **Article 11:** Students are strictly prohibited from bringing food and beverages into the examination room.

These regulations are effective from July 27, B.E. 2558 (2015) onwards.
