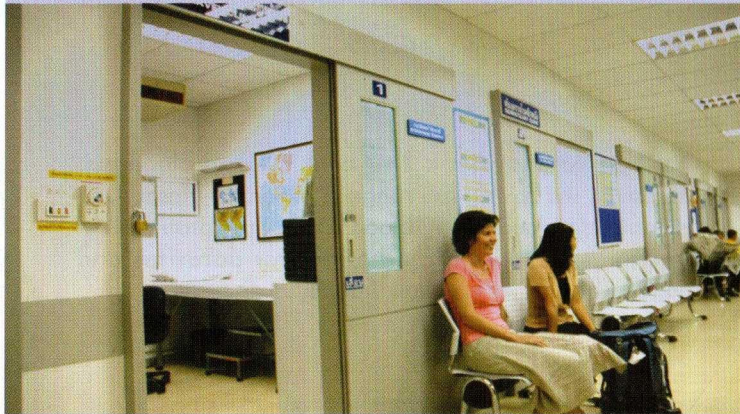


HOW TO ATTEND OUR CLINIC

Please bring your medical / immunization record and your passport.



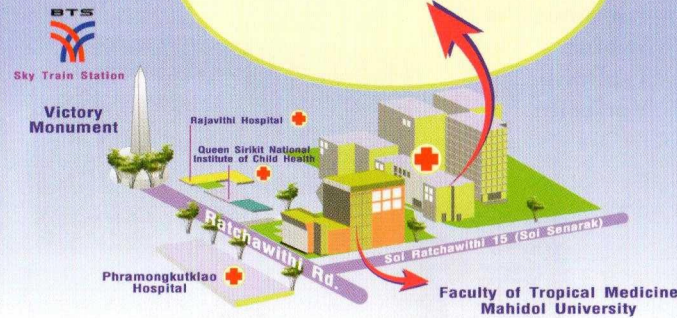

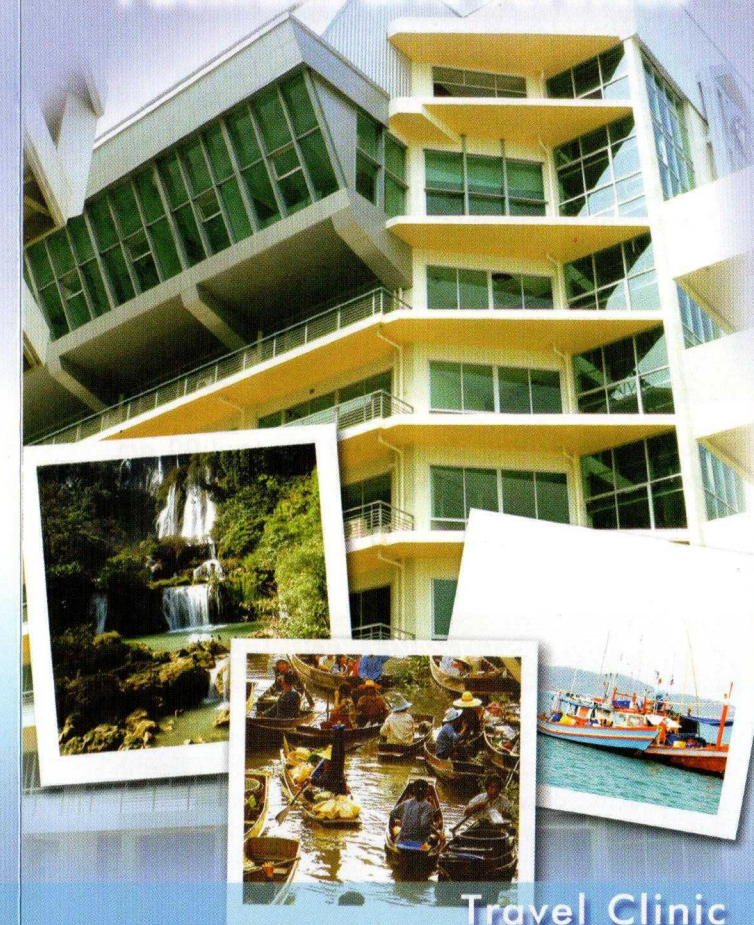

Facilities and Services

Travel Clinic is located in the Hospital for Tropical Diseases, Bangkok. It is a part of the Faculty of Tropical Medicine, Mahidol University. We specialize in travel medicine and tropical diseases, especially malaria.

Our services include:

- * Pre-and post-travel counseling
- * Vaccination and certification
- * On-site vaccinations (upon request)
- * Malaria prevention, including recommendations for prophylaxis
- * Health check-up and certificate
- * Information center for tropical diseases and emerging diseases
- * Laboratory diagnostic tests for malaria, parasite infestations, dengue infection, etc.
- * Medical treatments

SERVICE HOURS

Monday to Friday, from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm (except public holidays)

PRE-AND POST-TRAVEL COUNSELING

To ensure a safe and enjoyable journey, travelers should seek medical advices regarding their health and endemic diseases. We provide all necessary health information before and after traveling worldwide.

VACCINATIONS

Travelers requesting vaccination should bring their passport, medical and immunization records. Vaccinations are only given after counseling with our staff.

List of available vaccines in our clinic

- Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis
- Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B
- Influenza
- Japanese encephalitis
- Meningococcal
- Mumps, Measles, Rubella
- Poliomyelitis
- Rabies
- Typhoid
- Varicella



MALARIA PROPHYLAXIS

Malaria situations differ in various parts of the world. Antimalarial prophylaxis should be used only as advised by specialists in tropical diseases.

Over-the-counter antimalarial drugs are strictly prohibited.

HEALTH CHECK-UP AND CERTIFICATE

Any person requiring a health check-up or a health certificate can attend our clinic. We also provide standard physical examination, laboratory tests and chest X-ray. A health certificate will be issued after completion of the process.

LABORATORY DIAGNOSTIC FACILITIES

Our hospital provides a 24 - hour malaria diagnosis. Moreover, we have a full range of laboratory tests, such as complete blood count, blood sugar, lipid profile, liver function test, stool examinations for parasites and diagnosis for other endemic infectious diseases.

MEDICAL TREATMENT

Hospital for Tropical Diseases can offer standard in-and out-patient medical care for travelers suffering from illness while staying in Thailand.
