Student Admission to the Doctor of Pharmacy Program (International Program),
Faculty of Pharmacy
Direct Admission by the Faculty, Academic Year 2024 (Round 2nd)

The Faculty of Pharmacy, Mahidol University, is now accepting applications for the Doctor of Pharmacy Program (International Program) for the Academic Year 2024. (Round 2nd) through Direct Admission by Faculty. Mahidol University hereby announces the details as follows:

1. The total admission 21 persons

2. Admission requirements

2.1 General eligibility requirements

- 1) Applicants must be a person of Thai nationality or other and at least 16 years old as at the start date of the first semester of the academic year 2024 (Monday 5th August 2024).
- 2) Non-Thai applicants must hold a valid passport from their country of citizenship. The passport must be valid for at least six months beyond the last day of the application period. Applicants must be prepared, to obtain a visa to enter Thailand for interviews and medical clearance at the specified date and time.
- 3) Applicants must not be currently enrolled in any Pharmacy program at a public university in Thailand unless the applicant withdraws from the program before submitting the application.
- 4) Applicants must demonstrate good behavior and certify to Mahidol University their intention to study to the best of their abilities. They must also agree to adhere strictly to all existing and future rules and regulations of Mahidol University.
- 5) Applicants must have a person who will financially support their tuition fees and other study-related expenses until the completion of the program.

/6) Applicants...

- 6) Applicants must not have a confirmed admission status or be on the waiver list in the TCAS system for two consecutive terms. (Thai Nationality Only)
- 7) Applicants must be in good health and free from the following conditions: serious psychiatric disorders that may pose a risk to oneself and/or others, serious contagious diseases, deafness, muteness, physical deformities that could hinder the study and practice of pharmacy. Additionally, the Admission Committee of the Doctor of Pharmacy Program (International program), Faculty of Pharmacy, Mahidol University, may determine that other illnesses or disabilities could also hinder the study and practice of pharmacy. Applicants must provide a medical certificate as confirmation.

Remarks

1. Eligible applicants must submit a medical investigation form along with the requested results.
2. The assessment of diseases, symptoms, or physical deformities mentioned in Clause 7 is at the discretion of the Admission Committee of the Doctor of Pharmacy Program (International program), Faculty of Pharmacy, Mahidol University, and their decision is considered final.

2.2 General eligibility requirements

1) Educational qualifications:

- A. Graduating from Thai High Schools (M.6) without a specified study plan
OR graduating from International High Schools with Grade 12 in the American system or Year 13 in the English system
OR Obtaining a certificate equivalent to the criteria set by the Ministry of Education, in accordance with the Ministry of Education regulations regarding the comparison of domestic and foreign educational qualifications at the level of basic education B.E. 2563 (documents confirmation).
- B. High school transcripts must include four science-mathematics subjects, which should include: 1) Chemistry 2) Biology 3) Physics, and 4) Mathematics.

2) Test scores are as follows:

- A. For graduate students, a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) must be shown for 6 semesters at least 3.00

/B. A total score...

- B. A total score of the IB Diploma must be at least 35 points out of 45 points. Alternatively, a total score of International A Level must be at least ABB in three subjects from the science-mathematics subjects: 1) Chemistry, 2) Biology, 3) Physics, and 4) Mathematics. **However, applicants studying under the Basic Education Core Curriculum may not be required to present a total score of the IB Diploma or International A Level.**

Remarks Graduates of high school with other foreign curriculums are also eligible to apply. Consideration and approval will be under the Admission Committee of the Doctor of Pharmacy Program (International program), Faculty of Pharmacy, Mahidol University.

2.3 The standardized test scores should be dated within two years from the test date to the interview date as follows:

1) Knowledge standardized test scores

The Biomedical admission test (BMAT) score: No minimum score is required. **OR** The SAT Subject Test (SAT II) score is at least 650 in each of three subjects: 1) Biology M 2) Chemistry 3) Physics or Mathematics 2.

2) English language standardized test scores

A TOEFL Internet-based (TOEFL - iBT) score of at least 79 **OR** an IELTS Academic Test score of at least 6.5

3. Application process and required documents

3.1 Study the details in the admission announcement. (Please review the information independently for the benefit of applicants)

3.2 Apply via the online system at <https://pharmacy.mahidol.ac.th/interprogram/registration/>

3.3 Upload all application documents as follows:

- 1) Submit a profile picture size width 180-500 pixels and height 200-600 pixels, straight-faced photo, wearing a school uniform or formal outfit (without hat or sunglasses), against a white or blue background. The photo should be taken within the past 6 months, not digitally modified, and scanned as a JPEG-format file (.jpeg or .jpg), with a file size not exceeding 2 MB.
- 2) Fill out the application form completely as required, sign it with a blue ink pen, and scan it as a PDF file with a file size not exceeding 2 MB.

/3) Provide...

- 3) Provide a photocopy of your identification card (front side only) or passport on A4 size paper. Additionally, sign these two documents with a blue ink pen, scan them as PDF files with a file size not exceeding 2 MB. If the name or last name on the ID card or passport does not match other documents, provide a certified copy of the name change, sign it with a blue ink pen, scan it as a PDF file, and save all documents as one PDF file.
- 4) Submit a photocopy of the house registration for Thai applicants or proof of residence in Thailand for non-Thai applicants on A4 size paper. Sign these two documents with a blue ink pen, scan them as PDF files with a file size not exceeding 2 MB.
- 5) Academic documents must be copied on A4 size paper, and also the applicant's signature on these documents must be signed with a blue ink pen and scanned to pdf file. In case, there are 2 pages, please scan both the front and the back. The file size does should not exceed 2 MB and should include the following:
 - A. A copy of the high school certificate OR a bona fide certificate that indicates the student's status graduation in the academic year 2023.
 - B. IB Diploma and International A Level students must attach a certified recorded showing the predicted IB Diploma score or the predicted International A Level score.
 - C. A copy of official high school transcript.
- 6) The score reports of the standardized tests (TOEFL or IELTS, and BMAT or SAT II) must be copied on A4 size paper, and also the applicant's signature on these documents must be signed with a blue ink pen and scanned to pdf file, file size does not exceed 2 MB. (In case, there are 2 pages, please scan both the front and the back)
- 7) Statement of purpose should explain the reason and motivation for applying to study the Doctor of Pharmacy program (International Program) and life goals. It should be between 500 - 800 words, using Times New Roman, 12 Font size and single space. The statement of purpose must be saved as a pdf file; with a file size not exceeding 2 MB.
- 8) Portfolio, file size not exceeding 20 MB, and should include the following information:
 - A. Choose ONLY ONE topic from the four topics: 1) Academic, 2) Art, 3) Leadership, or 4) Social responsibility, then present 2- 3 activities/works related to the selected topic.
 - B. Present the activities/works in English only.

/C. Present...

- C. Present the activities/works in a vertical format, with a size of A4 page. Avoid using animation or video, and save the portfolio as a PDF file.
- D. Presenting all the information within 5 pages:
- 1st page:** Provide a brief introduction of the applicant, a short description of the chosen topic, and the reasons for selecting the topic.
- 2nd – 5th page:** Include photos of the activities/works along with a brief description.
- 9) The bank deposits slip for the payment of the application fee receiving from the bank must be scanned to pdf file, file size does not exceed 2 MB. The applicant must pay the application fee in the full amount of 3,400 baht, which is non-refundable. Online banking services can be used for payment. The name of the depositor should match the applicant's name and last name. The applicant is responsible for any fee charged by the bank or any currency conversion differences. - 10) The applicant must download the student's health record form of the faculty at <https://shorturl.asia/tq8Bm>. It must be certified by a public hospital or a private hospital as following 2.1 (7)

Remarks The applicant must show the student's health record form of the faculty (Original documents) on the date of the interview.

/11) The applicant...

11) The applicant must verify the accuracy of all uploaded application documents before confirming the application information. Once the online application has been submitted, the applicant must print out the application form from the admission system and sign the applicant's name with a blue ink pen. The applicant will not be able to edit any information in the system. If any corrections are needed, the applicant must notify the staff of the Division of Undergraduate Education (Miss.Parnphat, email: parnphat.gat@mahidol.ac.th), Faculty of Pharmacy, Mahidol University.

3.4 Recommendation letters from two of the applicant's teachers should include the details as follows:

- 1) The letter should introduce and recommend the applicant for acceptance into the Doctor of Pharmacy program (International Program).
- 2) The letter should be printed in English or Thai and should not exceed 1 page of A4 paper, the school seal should be affixed and sealed.
- 3) The applicant or teachers can be directly sent the letters out from the applicant's school to the Faculty of Pharmacy, Mahidol University (Doctor of Pharmacy program (International Program)). Alternatively, the applicants can submit the letters together with other application documents.

3.5 All application documents must be sent by postal mail or private logistic companies

 - The Faculty of Pharmacy, Mahidol University will collect information from applicants. The faculty will retain the applicants' data for a period of one year and six months for statistical analysis and research to improve quality and processes and to verify application evidences.

5.1 Interview scores (The interview will be conducted in English.)	30%
5.2 Academic achievement	30%
5.3 Pharmacy aptitude test scores (Written Examination)	30%
5.4 Portfolio and statement of purpose	10%

Remarks Admission consideration is at the discretion of the Admission Committee of the Doctor of Pharmacy Program

6. Confirmation of enrollments

Accepted applicants (the lists of successful candidates and reserve candidates) (Thai Nationality Only) must confirm the enrollment system in totally of 2 steps as follows:

1st step Both Thai and non-Thai accepted applicants must confirm the enrollment at the Faculty of Pharmacy, Mahidol University at a given date and time. For Thai applicants who fail to confirm, the Faculty of Pharmacy will not send their names to the clearing house system (we will announce the schedule of the clearing house system TCAS on announcement of the list of accepted) **and**

2nd step Thai accepted applicants must confirm their enrollment through the clearing house system scheduled by TCAS at www.mytcas.com by choosing only one selected field of study from the qualified programs. Failure to confirm eligibility within the specified period will be considered a waiver, and applicants cannot claim any rights later.

/7. Criteria...

7. Criteria for evaluating english proficiency for degree approval

Undergraduate students must pass an English proficiency test before graduation, following the conditions and criteria established by the university. This requirement is considered as one of the considerations for degree approval, in accordance with the Mahidol University Regulations on Diploma and Undergraduate Studies and the Mahidol University Announcement on English Competence Standards for Undergraduate Students of Mahidol University B.E. 2566 (2023) Announced on 20 December, 2023
