


Meeting on research collaboration with K-Agro Innovation Institution (KAI)

On Tuesday, July 13, 2021, from 04:00 p.m. to 05:00 p.m., MUPY's administrative team led by Assoc. Prof. Surakit Nathisuwan, the Dean, together with Assoc. Prof. Dr. Doungdaw Chantasart, Assistant Dean for Research and Innovation, and the faculty members attended an online meeting on the future research collaboration between MUPY and K-Agro Innovation Institution (KAI) via the Cisco Webex platform.
