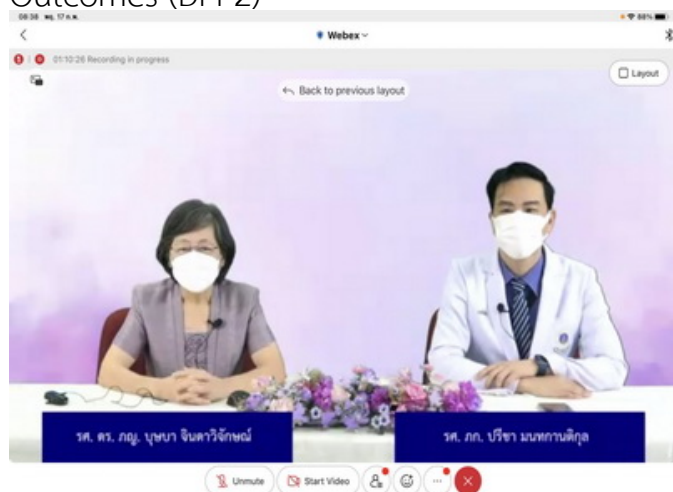


## Online Conference on Drug Interactions: From PK/PD to Patient Safety & Optimal Outcomes (DI-P2)
