## MUPY welcomed Exchange Students from Meiji Pharmaceutical University

On December 1, 2022, during 09.00 a.m. - 12.00 p.m., Assist. Prof. Supatat Chumnumwat, Assistant Dean for Academic Affairs, along with Assist. Prof. Jennis Meanwatthana and Dr. Amporn Songkasiri provided a warm welcome to two exchange students from Meiji Pharmaceutical University (MPU), Japan. The orientation meeting was held at Room 404, Rajaratana Building. Two Japanese undergraduate students included 1) Ms. Kazuna FUJIHASHI 2) Ms. Keiko KUMAGAI. They participated in the Professional Training Program in Clinical Pharmacy physically arranged by MUPY's International Relations Unit during December 1, 2022, until January 27, 2023 at the Faculty of Pharmacy and affiliated training sites such as teaching hospital of Mahidol University, BMA's Healthcare Service Center, Chaophraya Abhaibhubejhr Hospital, and community pharmacy. The objective of this training program was to provide the participating students with international experiences focusing on clinical pharmacy in hospitals, healthcare centers, and drug store, allowing them to explore and compare the healthcare system of Thailand and Japan as well as traditional medicine in both countries.
