

MUPY's Dean joined UiTM's Class as an Invited Speaker

On December 13, 2022, from 09.00 a.m. - 11.00 a.m., Assoc. Prof. Surakit Nathisuwan, the Dean of the Faculty of Pharmacy, accepted to be an invited speaker to deliver a special lecture entitled “Anticoagulation Therapy” in a class for graduate students of the Faculty of Pharmacy, Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM), Malaysia. Having been hosted by UiTM, the lecture was held via the Microsoft Teams platform and was directly livestreamed to the graduate students in UiTM’s Clinical Pharmacy and Pharmacy Practice Program. This program aimed to provide an opportunity for UiTM’s graduate students to learn more about a Anticoagulation Therapy. Also, they had a chance to explore Thailand’s public healthcare and its pharmacy system. This activity helped promote an exchange of learning between Malaysian students and foreign scholars from partner universities.
